BY CAR

Take the Autostrada del Sole "A1" highway, turn off at the Arezzo exit and follow the signs for "Arezzo-Bibbiena-Sansepolcro". After about 5 km, turn right onto Via Luigi Galvani and continue for approx. 500 mt then turn left onto Via Lebole. Take the underpass and turn left onto Via Fratelli Lumiere. You will see the Hotel AC Arezzo sign; the Congress venue is a building behind the AC Hotel Arezzo.

BY PLANE

The nearest international airports to the ICLO Center are: Florence (Amerigo Vespucci), Pisa (Galileo Galilei) and Bologna (Guglielmo Marconi). The intercontinental airports are: Rome (Leonardo da Vinci) and Milan (Malpensa). The connections from these airports to the Center are the same described for the rail networks.

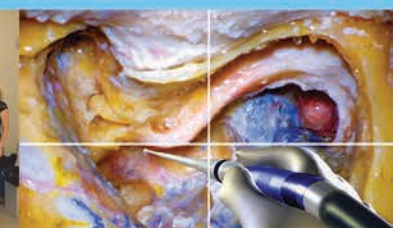
