Surgical Anatomy, Techniques and Step-by-Step Dissection

Tavola I THE SIX ZONES OF RHINOPLASTY

- I DORSUM**
Reduction of the osseocartilaginous hump; the profile line is re-established.
- II OSTEOTOMIES**
Controlled fracture of the nasal pyramid to narrow and realign the bony vault.
- III MIDDLE VAULT**
Spreader grafts restore the internal valve after dorsal resection.
- IV TIP**
Suture techniques and grafts define rotation, projection and definition.
- V ALAR BASE**
Measured excision at the sill narrows the nostril without distorting the rim.
- VI SEPTUM**
Cartilage is straightened, and harvested as the principal graft source.

Following an introductory theoretical session, participants will take part in a step-by-step dissection on anatomical specimens, exploring open and closed approaches, septal and tip surgery, osteotomies, middle vault reconstruction and graft harvesting and placement.
